Purpose of the Award

The purpose of the Outstanding Major's Club Award is to recognize and reward student majors' clubs at colleges and universities who have demonstrated a commitment to the profession with club membership, service to the college or university and service to the community.

Qualifications for Award

Nominees must:

- 1. Total # of members in club
- 2. Have current membership in GAHPERD
- 3. Must provide evidence of service to the college and the community.

Selection/Recognition Process

The completed application for this award is reviewed by a screening committee appointed by the Vice-President of the GAHPERD division sponsoring this award. The recipient and all applicants for this award are notified by letter from the division's Vice-President six to eight weeks prior to GAHPERD's annual convention. The award winner(s) is/are expected to be registered and present at the convention and to be in attendance at the Awards Ceremony. The Vice-President's letter will include details regarding the date and time of this special event.

Required Materials for Application

Applications must contain all required materials to be reviewed by the screening committee.

The required materials for this award are as follows:

- 1. A cover/nomination form
- 2. Letter of nomination from the club President and the faculty advisor
- 3. A list of student members
- 4. Descriptions of activities completed by the club
